
Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) are essential for building a strong partnership between parents and teachers, ensuring student success

Empowering Young Minds through Sports



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



A Sorting Activity was organized for Pre-KG students on **25th August 2025**. The little learners actively participated in sorting **objects based on colour, shape, and size**.


The activity helped enhance their **observation skills, logical thinking, and fine motor coordination**. It was a joyful and engaging hands-on learning experience for the tiny tots.


